



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS OUR COMMUNITY CAN?

Our Community CAN is a community-wide food drive that unites everyone in the fight against hunger and promotes volunteer service and community engagement. The drive this year will begin on July 15 when bags will be distributed by hunger champions in their neighborhoods and will end on July 22 when the bags of food are collected. This campaign

is a simple, easy way to take action and help stock pantries during the summer months when donations are at their lowest. It's a great activity for individuals, children, families, or groups.

HOW DOES THE FOOD DRIVE WORK?

You can sign up to be a Hunger Champion and distribute bags and flyers to your neighbors. Harvesters will provide you with the necessary supplies – plastic grocery bags and a customizable flyer that you can affix to your bags.

1. Pick up bags from Harvesters or the designated location in your area and deliver them to your neighbors on Saturday, July 15.
2. On Saturday, July 22, pick up the bags of donated food from your neighbors and bring them to Harvesters or one of our drop-off locations. Drop-off locations will be posted online.
