



Harvester At-Home CANstruction 2020 – Evergy’s American Flag Assembly Instructions

Thank you for choosing our design. Please read all the instructions before starting. There are some tips at the end that may be helpful.

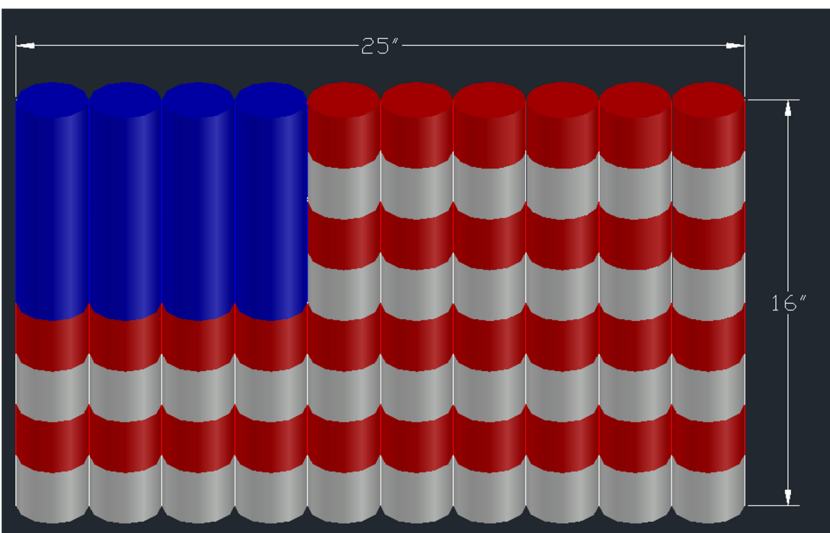
Materials Needed

- 32 cans - Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup – \$1.29 each
- 8 cans - Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom soup – \$1.19 each



Area Needed

The structure will be approximately 16 inches tall, 25 inches long and 1 can width wide.





Building the Structure

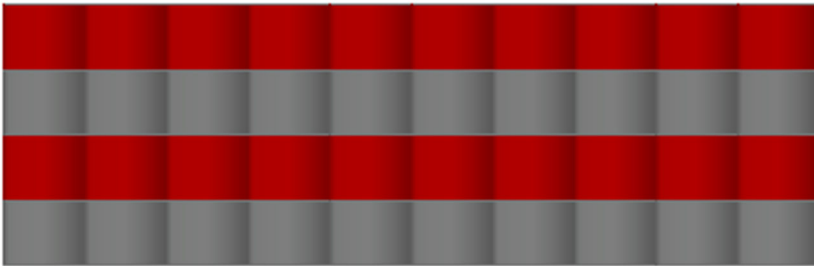
Step 1: First layer or row of cans

You will need (10) Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup cans with the red part of the label on top. The cans should be placed as close together as possible to each other.



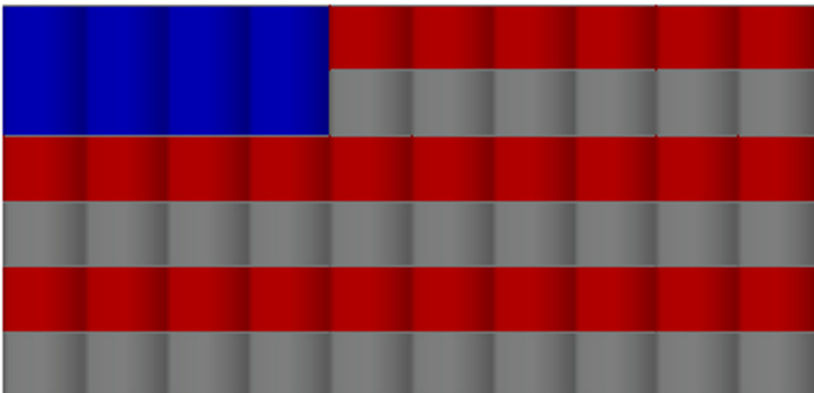
Step 2: Second layer of cans

Place a second layer of (10) Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup cans on top of the first layer with the red part of the label on top.



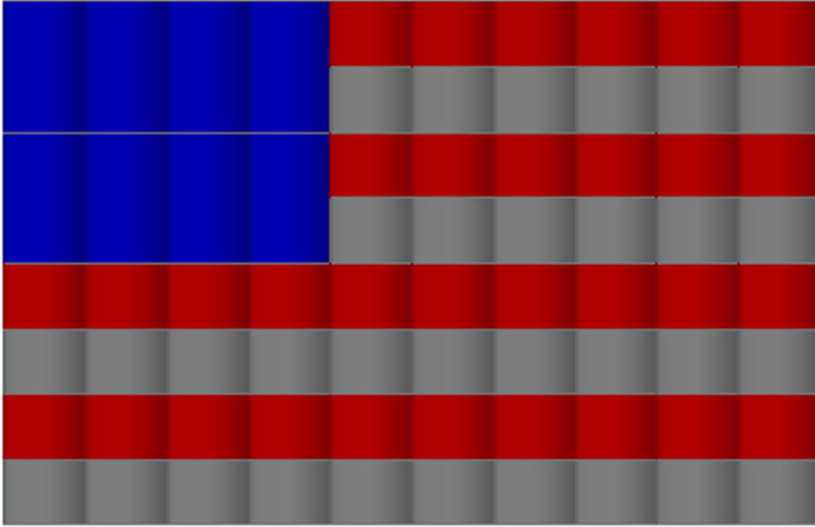
Step 3: Third layer of cans

Place (4) Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom soup cans starting on the left and stacked on top of the Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup cans. Then stack the next six columns with a Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup can.



Step 4: Fourth layer of cans

Place (4) Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom soup cans, starting on the left, on top of the Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom soup cans. Then place the Campbell's® Chicken Noodle soup cans on the remaining six columns. This will complete the structure.



Building tips

- You could build this column by column instead of by row or layer. The cans may be less stable and may fall over until you get the second column built to help support it.
- To get the Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom cans to look more like stars on a blue background, make sure all the cans are rotated the same direction so the blue part of the label with the bowl of soup on the top part of the label is facing out toward the front.
- If Hy-Vee® Cream of Mushroom soup cans aren't available, a similar soup can may be substituted. Hy-Vee® Cream of Potato soup cans are almost identical to the cream of mushroom cans.
