



## Four Good 2021 - FAQ Information Page

1. Is there an age requirement for Four Good? Yes, Four Good is a 21+ event.
2. What movie will be showing? Ford v Ferrari – Rated PG-13 - Running time: 2 hours 32 minutes
3. Where is Four Good 2021? Heartland Motorsports Par - 7530 SW Topeka Blvd, Topeka, KS 66619
4. Heartland Motorsports Park is a big place. Where will I enter? Gate E
5. Is there a rain date? Yes, the rain date is October 13. Please read the addendum at the bottom of this FAQ for full details.
6. How can I ensure I am parked next to my guests? In order to keep traffic flowing at the entrance/check-in, we ask that if you would like your vehicles parked together that you enter the facility caravan-style. This way your group can be directed to park next to each other. Regardless of where you park, you may bring folding chairs and gather in a spot next to another guest's vehicle, but please do your best to follow COVID-19 protocols.
7. How will parking work? Parking is first come, first served. Once you arrive, you will be checked in and directed to parking - see above.
8. What is the general schedule for the evening?
  - **5:30 p.m. Check-In Opens** - Make your way into Heartland Motorsports Park. Parking is first come first served.
  - **6:00 p.m. Event Begins** - The beer garden opens, entertainment begins and our DJ will be spinning tunes!
  - **6:30 p.m. Food Service Begins** - Come hungry! We're going to serve up a variety of the most delicious foods and beverages from some of the best places around town.
  - **7:30 p.m. Movie Begins** - The sun is set and it is time to and enjoy Ford v Ferrari on the big screen!
  - **10 p.m. Head Home** - Everyone to depart after the movie.
9. What time will food service begin? 6:30 p.m., although you will receive an event box with food & beverage items upon arrival. **PLEASE ARRIVE BY 6:30 p.m.** to take maximum advantage of all hot food service!
10. May I bring extra guests in my car if they don't have an event pass? Unfortunately, no. For safety and capacity reasons, we can only admit guests that have pre-purchased VIP Event Passes.
11. Where can I buy additional VIP Event Passes for my friends who would like to attend too? We are officially sold-out this year (thank you for your support!) and due to capacity limitations cannot accommodate additional guests.
12. May we have more than two people in a car? Yes, provided you have adequate Event Passes (each Event Pass is good for 2 event attendees only), you can have as many people as you'd like (safely!) in your car.
13. Do I have to sit in my car the whole time? Our parking guides will ensure that all vehicles will be appropriately distanced. You can enjoy the evening from your car or feel free to bring lawn chairs to use in your space.

14. What will come in my event box? It will be filled with premium pre-packaged food, non-alcoholic beverages and other goodies for the evening.
15. Do I have to wear a mask? Yes, we ask that you wear a mask in common areas such as restrooms and in the Beer Tent when not drinking.
16. How do I get additional food or drinks delivered to my car? You can raise the car flag provided in your event box, and your server will be right over to assist you.
17. What do I do with my trash/waste? We'll have volunteers available to help collect and manage your waste.
18. Will there be restrooms on-site? Yes, restrooms will be plentiful.
19. What restaurants will be on-site? You will be able to savor amazing food deliveries (straight to your car) from Engroff Catering, Oleander Café and Tagine Moroccan Cuisine.
20. What is recommended attire? Casual attire with comfortable shoes.

### Weather Plan Addendum

**Four Good 2021 Weather Plan: We have a rain date of Wednesday, October 13 scheduled, but please read on for a detailed plan.**

In the week before Four Good we will be closely monitoring the weather and, if necessary, will email a modified event plan to registered attendees by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, October 6.

The only reason Four Good would not go on at all on October 7, would be an immediate danger due to severe weather or heavy rain. Severe weather would include lightening, torrential winds, tornado threats, heavy downpours, etc. Guest, volunteer and staff safety is our primary concern! Fortunately, many aspects of the event can take place even if it's lightly raining, so we have plans in place for a rainy event if the forecast calls for it.

If severe weather conditions exist, we will move the event to the rain date of Wednesday, October 13 with event modifications.

Right now we have several scenarios:

- Blue Skies – no changes needed
- Light Rain – No changes needed. As long as screen viewing of the movie is good, you are welcome to stay for the movie. Event staff will modify and communicate our onsite food and drink distribution plan to attendees onsite.
- Severe Weather – like lightening, torrential winds, tornado threats, etc. – please stay home for your safety and the event will be rescheduled for October 13. If the weather forecasts this, we will be in communication with you. \*If severe weather develops after the event is underway, guests may be asked to evacuate the event.

If the event is rescheduled for the rain date of October 13 and registrants cannot make that date, we shall not offer refunds. We are, however, happy to adjust your sponsorship tax letter to reflect that no goods and services have been received so that you can deduct the full amount of your sponsorship. We hope that by proactively planning for these scenarios, we offer you an idea of what to expect and limit any additional stress related to unknown weather forecasts.
